

2022 Broome Open

Conditions of Play

- The Broome Open will be a 36-hole Stroke event for A grade Players and Stableford for B and C Grade Players, consisting of two 18-hole rounds held on the 23rd and 24th July 2022.
- Players will be graded according to a handicap range to be determined once nominations close.
- All entrants must have an Australian handicap and must be a member of a recognised club.
- The Match Committee of Broome Golf Club will address all disputes and its decision/s shall be final.
- All players must report to the tee 15 minutes prior to the indicated tee off time. Failure to do so could result in disqualification.
- The Entry Fee of \$50 for players covers fees for the event, plus Food on Saturday and Sunday.
- Alcoholic beverages for consumption on course, will be available from the clubhouse and on course via the drinks cart.
- In the event of a tie for first place winners will be determined by the Mi-Club countback system.
- No player will be eligible for more than one major prize.
- Saturday groups consist of a mixture of Grades with the Sunday groups being seeded.
- The Committee will attempt to honour Special requests but cannot guarantee all requests will be met
